

Recent reform legislation as well as closer scrutiny by major health insurers have been less tolerant of serious patient care errors. Private insurers beginning in 2008 have signaled their intolerance by not paying for deficient care (Never Events) in those instances.

Never Event occurrences in their coded format, included as multiple diagnoses, are important data element inclusions within a facility's Business Intelligence system.

The extended discharge record containing adverse event data elements brings analyses beyond just quality of care aspects. Risk management issues and financial calculations based upon statistics bring more extensive analyses by getting at unrecognized associations with Never Events such as order/test/med profiling and forecasting negative patient revenues.
